



JOB OPENING: Construction Foreman

Green Hammer is seeking a flexible individual with diverse carpentry skills and an instinct for customer service to serve as a Construction Foreman. The Foreman will self-perform a broad range of rough and finish carpentry tasks while coordinating the flow of work through the job site. The Foreman is responsible for meeting and communicating daily production goals, anticipating potential issues and raising them with the Superintendent, managing problems as they arise, engaging the jobsite team to arrive at a unified solution. The Foreman is the Green Hammer contact onsite in absence of a Superintendent. Previous exposure to green building techniques is preferred, but not required. All candidates are expected to have reliable transportation and a basic set of carpentry tools.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Work with Green Hammer and trade partner personnel onsite to comply with OSHA safety standards.
- Plans daily production activities, equipment and material needs with Superintendent prior to on-site work, to ensure that critical path items and general daily production is incorporated into a work plan.
- Communicates goals to crew members and keeps crew on track.
- Confirms with Superintendent that materials will be on site when needed by reviewing the Site at the end of each work day.
- Supports crew in solving production questions and issues, understanding when a problem can be solved at the crew level and when the Superintendent should be involved.
- Performs deconstruction, framing, air sealing, window install, trim, paint and punch list work and other work assigned as needed.
- Ensures that crew and trade partners leave job sites clean and organized, performing job site cleanup when necessary.
- Models approved material re-use and recycling behavior for crew and subcontractors.
- Compiles close-out requirements, including owner's manual, warranties.

Qualifications + Requirements

- College degree preferred in construction/architecture/engineering or equivalent experience.
- Three to five years of experience working in the construction field.
- Demonstrated proficiency and dedication to sustainable design and construction, and building science, including a familiarity with sustainable building products and practices and third party certifications.
- Ability to understand plans, financial projections and other related project management documents.
- Excellent organizational skills and high attention to detail.
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills.
- Project management and supervision skills.

- Decision making ability and leadership skills.
- Strong familiarity with Microsoft Office suite, particularly Microsoft Excel.
- Overall excellent computer literacy.
- Experience with BIM/CAD preferred.
- Willingness to work as part of a unified team and engage in group process.
- Reliable transportation and a valid driver's license.
- Sustainable/Energy Efficiency Training preferred but not required
