

JOB OPENING: Portland Commercial Superintendent

The Superintendent supports the project team during design phases and provides on-site coordination of day-to-day field operations for all phases of the project in accordance with Green Hammer's Unified Design Build Process. This includes coordinating subcontractors, material/equipment management, adherence to project schedule and budget, ensuring jobsite safety, and overall quality control.

The Superintendent is responsible for establishing a professional work environment based on Green Hammer's mission and values.

Responsibilities include but are not limited to:

- Review and provide feedback on construction documents during the design phase.
- Review RFP's for subcontractor/vendor procurement.
- Review subcontractor/vendor proposal and contract documents.
- Support the Project Engineer during procurement phase.
- Negotiate subcontracts and vendor pricing to achieve best value in order to meet overall project budget.
- Create and maintain a culture that values safety, health and cleanliness.
- Ensure understanding of and compliance with project polices for all onsite personnel.
- Manage the day-to-day site activities to ensure the project milestone dates and overall schedule completion date is met or improved.
- Schedule subcontractors, consultants, inspections, and vendors to ensure timely completion of project.
- Perform project look-ahead to ensure upcoming events and constraints are communicated, tracked and are being proactively tended to.
- Ensure that all aspects of the project are compliant with contract terms, legal, and community requirements.
- Ensure that subcontractors are in compliance with their contracted scope of work.
- Identify/solve conflicts in construction progress and communicate them to project team for collaboration or resolution.
- Continually perform quality assurance inspections and document any deficiencies.
- Ensure all installed work is in compliance with third party certification programs, such as Net Zero Energy and Water, LEED, Earth Advantage, Passive House, etc.
- Conduct and/or attend pre-construction, acceptance, progress, client, and other project meetings.
- Meet with client representatives as needed to discuss the status of projects.
- Manage or self-perform (as needed) in house scopes of work.
- Mentor and direct field staff.
- Identify, communicate, negotiate, facilitate changes.
- Support Project Engineer in drafting change orders.
- Managing the punch list and project closeout process to assure timely completion.

Qualifications + Requirements

- Minimum 10 years experience in the construction industry and 5 years of experience as Superintendent on commercial projects, new building construction and remodels.
- Demonstrated dedication to sustainability and building science, including a familiarity with sustainable building products and practices.
- Willingness to work as part of a unified team and engage in group process.
- Proven fluency of construction terms, scheduling, and planning concepts.
- Proficiency with spreadsheets, email and other software used in the construction industry.
- Excellent organizational, presentation, and interpersonal skills.
- Proficient in Microsoft Office Suite, particularly Microsoft Excel.
- Appropriate tools to perform typically required carpentry work.
- Reliable transportation and a valid driver's license.
